2 | Comfort

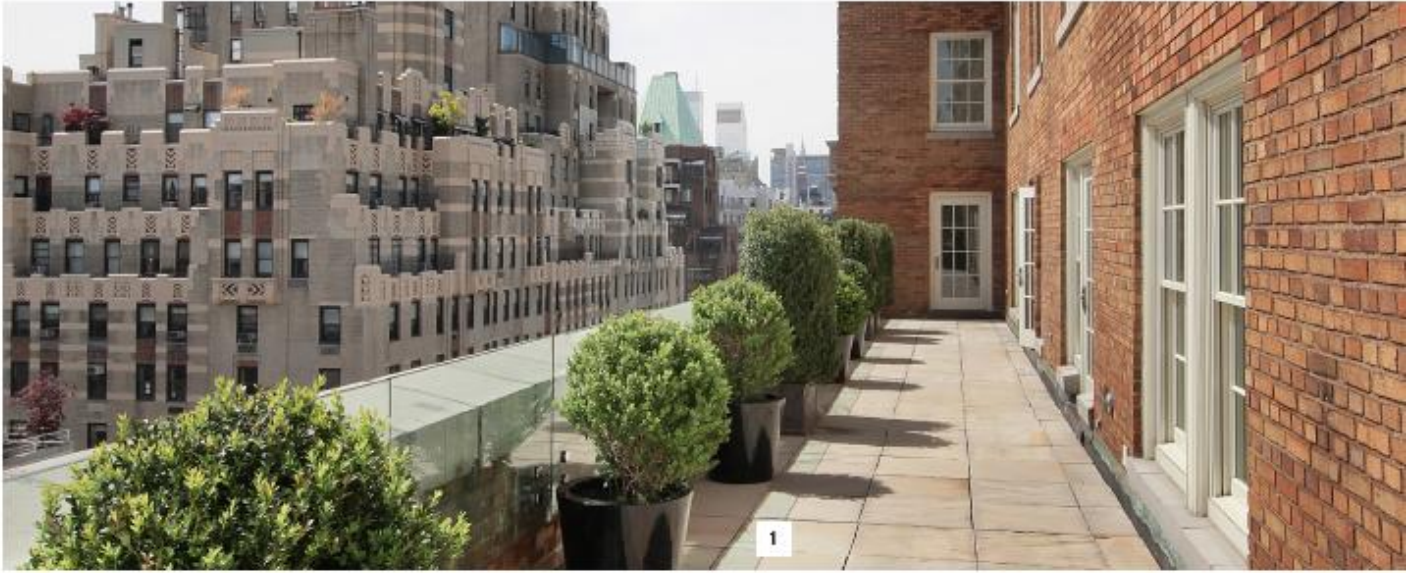
