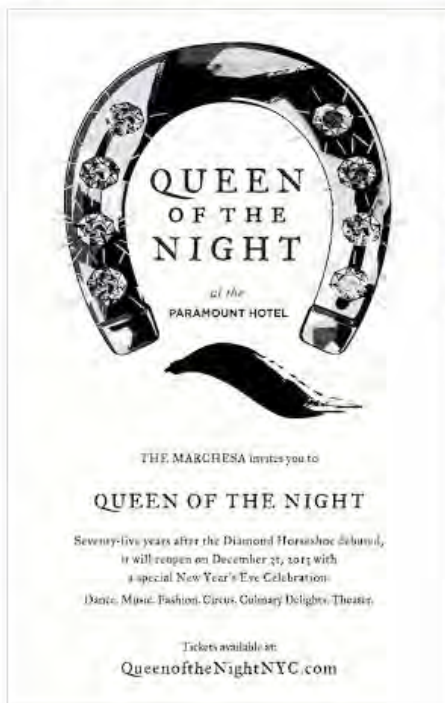

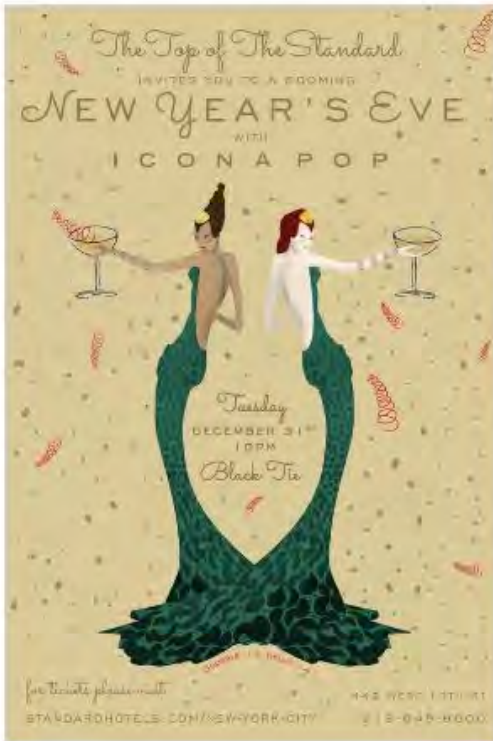

NYE with Icona Pop



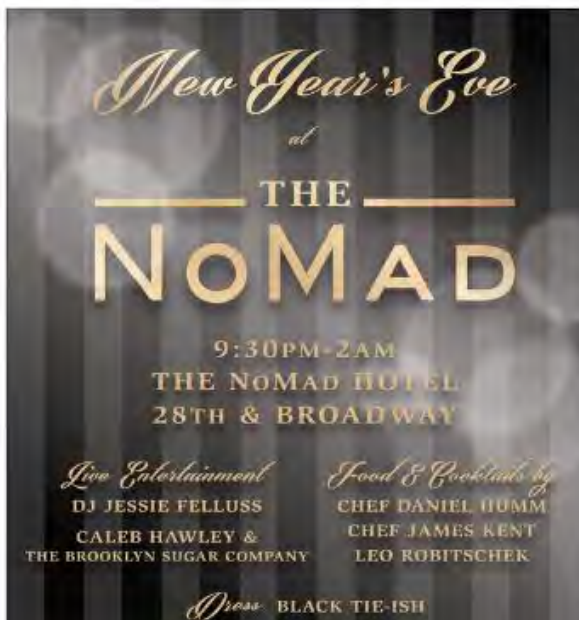
