Qatar considers building floating Finnish hotels to handle World Cup demand

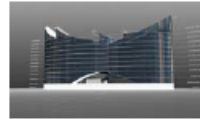
The Qatar Tourism Authority plans to invest \$20bn on tourism infrastructure development as the country prepares to host the 2022 FIFA World Cup. According to an official report, Qatar plans to build 45,000 additional hotel rooms to ensure that it meets FIFA's room capacity requirement of 60,000 rooms. Some 21 new hotels are planned to open between 2012 and 2017.

A Finnish architecture firm that has developed a space-saving, energy-efficient concept of 'floating hotels' has had a successful meeting with Qatari authorities. The architecture firm has developed the concept of the 'floating hotel' in conjunction with the Almaco Group of Finland, which specialises in marine construction. The modular construction methodology used for the concept can also be applied to labour accommodation and sports venues.

A 'floating hotel' is "a great alternative for areas where all land is fully developed and/or difficult to develop.".
